080919 Planning:

19/01368/OUT Land South West Of Allotment Gardens Hall Lane. Outline application for the construction of 5 dwellings with garages and an access road. Access being sought all other matters reserved. Sandon Parish Council feels the needs of this site have been addressed in this application. We do have some concerns:

- 1: 5 dwellings could be classed as overdevelopment.
- 2: Our main concern is that this site is contaminated by the years of dumping that has taken place, which needs to be addressed more fully. The proposal talks about the removal of the spoil heaps across the site or reduce the height of the existing banked areas of the site, which we feel is contradictory. Are they removing the spoil or not? We would like to see it all removed.
- 3: Pleased with the Anglian Ecology Ecological Survey report, and the recommendation of monitoring the habitat during clearance of the site etc.
- 4: The flooding report confuses us. It says the site is located within Flood Zones 3,2 and
- 1. Flood Zone 3 High Probability is defined but mainly in Zone 2 and 1. Then says the hazard within the site boundary would be very low, however, the hazard along Hall Lane would be Dangerous for most for 22m then very low thereafter. This does not make sense! The site is next to Sandon Brook and will be at the lowest point unless these properties are going to be built very high which is not clear on this outline application, therefore flooding is a real possibility. We assume piling will be required for all these properties.

19/01423/FUL The Fold, Woodhill Road. Demolition of existing porch. Two storey front and side extensions and rear extensions. No observations

19/01455/FUL Howe Farm, Southend Road, Construction of two storey rear extension and first floor side extension. No observations

19/01386/FUL Site At Wayside Mayes Lane, Conversion and extension of existing dwelling/ commercial space to create new three bed dwelling. Including alterations to fenestration and raising of roof height. The outbuilding previously used to repair cars etc. they now wish to remove the commercial use and change use to a three bed bungalow to live in permanently.

Sandon Parish Council wishes to have this application refused. The proposed site is not

within the curtilage of Wayside. This is rural land where a very large three bedroom house is totally inappropriate for use as a permanent residence bungalow.

The existing outbuilding with accommodation was permitted, which can be understood with this size of plot to provide accommodation for rural workers.

This site is within the East Hanningfield Wooded Farmland Landscape Character Area, and as such we feel that in this rural location it is inappropriate for the conversion to a large dwelling.

DC-1 controlling development in the Metropolitan Green Belt where planning will be refused unless directly related to Agriculture or Forestry.

DC-2 where planning permission will be refused for development within the areas shown as the Rural Area, new building will be refused if not used for agriculture nor an essential small-scale facility for outdoor sport or recreation, and does not preserve the openness of the rural area. This is a huge very modern three bedroom residential property. It will impact on the openness, appearance and character of this area.

This is effectively the building of a new property behind the existing house, with a separate entrance from Mayes Lane
