060322 Current Issues.

- (a) Maintenance and ditch clearing Cllr Calmeyer to delay sourcing two further quotes for the final part of the Corner Green clearance until after summer. Meeting agreed to the quote of c.£1,240 for the additional repairs of the tractor. Decision on whether we keep it to be taken later in the year after the growing season. It was agreed to tidy up the eastern side of the sports ground that borders Rectory Chase. The damage left by the storm would be cleared up, and remedial tree and hedge work be carried out. 22/00128/FUL 2 Hulls Lane. Demolition of existing garage, construction of single storey side extension with attached two storey double garage. No observations

22/00282/FUL 7 St Swithins Cottage, Southend Road. Part single, part two storey rear extension. Part single, part two storey side/front extension. Alterations to existing fenestration. No observations

22/05513/CAT Elm Tree Cottage, Woodhill Road. Back garden: a) x1 - Mature Acer - reduce in height up to 4m. For general maintenance and good tree health b) x1 - Young Acer - fell in preparation for rear kitchen extension c) x1 - Plum - Reduce to height of 6m. For general maintenance and good tree health d) x1 - Beech - Reduce to height of 4m. The tree is growing in bush formation with multiple trunks rather than one large trunk; for general maintenance and good tree health e) x1 - Cherry - reduce to a height of 4m and spread of 3m. Allow light to the underlying shrubs and for general maintenance and good tree health f) x1 - Silver birch - removal one a dead bough Front garden in front hedge- h) x1 dead tree - possibly an offshoot from a previously long felled elm - removal as dead. No observations

22/00301/FUL Maple Tree House, Woodhill Road. Retrospective application for the construction of a detached two-storey dwelling and creation of new vehicular access. No observations

22/00347/FUL Barns North Of Willowside, East Hanningfield Road. Change of Use and alterations of agricultural building to a residential rural workers dwelling. Refurbishment of a second existing building for continued agricultural use.

Sandon Parish Council does not agree to the conversion of Barn 1 into a Residential Rural Workers Dwelling. This property only has one field, which is managed at present without the need for a live in rural worker. Management of a field is not a full time occupation.

This should be a full residential application.

We feel an assured agricultural occupancy should be put on this barn, if permitted, when the worker has been employed in agriculture (by any employer) for 91 weeks of the last 104, including paid holiday and sick leave, and: the tenant works 35 hours or more a week. the accommodation is owned by the farmer, or arranged by them

The pictures of Barn 2 in need of refurbishment show no agricultural equipment or storage. The debris looks like it was left from the time when it was a chicken shed a very long time ago.

Access is via a private drive that has recently been tarmacked by the adjacent property. This is for agricultural use only. We feel if this permission were to be granted a new drive for residential use should be formed.

We accept the need to refurbish Barn 2.
